In 1993 the U.S. Congress passed the Religious Freedom and Restoration Act [42 U.S.C. § 2000bb(a)] which allows for the religious use of marijuana on federal grounds; during the course of a religious ceremony. In May of 2002, the U.S. Court of Appeals for the 9th Circuit upheld the RFRA and declared "RELIGION" is a defense to the use of marijuana on Federal Property in accordance with a religious practice. **The Court ruled that a Rastafarian whose Jamaica-based religion regards marijuana as a sacrament that brings believers closer to divinity could not be prosecuted for merely possessing marijuana in the "federal realms."** People of Guam v. Guerrero, 290 F.3d 1210 (9th Cir. 2002).

**Since Dec. 20th, 2003 local provocateurs, Pat Duff and NJWEEDMAN, have demonstrated this fact by smoking at the LIBERTY BELL while holding a religious ceremony.**
